The Māori Electoral Option - Te Kōwhiringa Pōti Māori - is a unique choice for Māori in Aotearoa. It lets you choose which electoral roll you’re on: Māori roll or general roll.

Your roll choice decides which electorate you vote in, and the candidates you choose from.

If you are Māori, you choose which electoral roll you want to be on when you first enrol to vote.

If you’re already enrolled, you can change your roll type at any time, except:

- in the 3 months before a general election
- in the 3 months before the local elections which are held every 3 years
- before a parliamentary by-election if the change would move you into the electorate where the by-election is being held

If you would like to change the roll you’re on before this year’s election, you need to do it by midnight, Thursday 6 August.

Make sure you are enrolled early, by 4 October 2026.
