

- -Phillippa the EM, doesn't feel comfortable sending staff to this school, despite the feedback from the police.

This document is a risk assessment for Whangaruru School, Russell Road, Punaruku 0184.

## **Executive Summary**

The Electorate Manager for Northland has information that there is a local dispute between two groups associated with Whangaruru School, which has resulted in school staff being harassed

My enquiries reveal the threats are directed solely to two members of school staff.

There is no identified heightened risk to any electoral staff, or to voters.

I recommend that this VP is suitable and safe to be used.

#### Introduction

Whangaruru School is a small rural school with a principal, three teachers and two administration staff.

Phillippa (Northland Electorate Manager) has received information of an ongoing dispute between two groups associated with the school. This dispute has resulted in death threats being made to school staff.

Information suggests the dispute is not connected to the election in anyway and is purely a dispute between the groups and the school. This has resulted in a principal leaving in the last two months.

I have enquired into the nature of the dispute and have discovered it is related to the last principal, who left suddenly. The nature of the dispute is subject to an NDA (non-disclosure agreement).

The inability of the staff to counter accusations made by the community, because of the NDA, is the reason for the ongoing dispute and the threats.

One of the staff affected by threats has assured me there is no risk to any of our election staff. The threats have only been directed at two members of the school staff.

Checks with the Northland Police Operations Manager indicated there have been no incidents connected to the school reported on Police systems.

The EM is investigating whether we can get a Māori warden to be present at the site.

## Recommendations

I recommend that from a security perspective, Whangaruru School can safely be used as a Voting Place on Election Day.

I further recommend we do have a security guard for reassurance. An additional briefing should be given to the guard to ensure they are vigilant and aware of a small but potential risk.
