OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2023/108

On Tuesday 21 November 2023 you made a request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA) for the following information:

Please find attached the consolidated review for the 2020 General Election.

The Commission is still undergoing the review process for the 2023 General Election and will be completed by early 2024. Therefore, this part of your request is denied under section 18(e) of the Act. We will provide you with the consolidated review for the 2023 General Election when it has been completed.

In the interests of transparency, we release responses to Official Information Act requests every 3 months. We will publish this response with your personal details redacted.
