OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2023/69

On 14 October you made a request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA) for the following information:

I request all internal communication, including briefings, memos, emails, text messages and/or instant messaging messages (such as those from Microsoft Teams) relating to the operation and/or closure of the Ngaio Playcentre on 50 Silverstream Road, Crofton Downs, Wellington as part of the 2023 election.

Copies of all communication between staff and Ngaio Playcentre that relate to the closure of Ngaio Playcentre as a voting place for Election Day are attached.

Some contact details, such as phone numbers, email addresses and some names have been withheld under s 9(2)(a) of the OIA which relates to the privacy of natural persons.

In each case where redactions have been made under section 9(2)(a), consideration has been given and I am satisfied that the reasons for withholding of the information are not outweighed by other considerations which render it desirable in the public interest to make that information available.

In the interests of transparency, we release responses to Official Information Act requests every 3 months. We will publish this response with your personal details redacted.
