1) Position titles at the voting booth.

The attached pdf 'Voting place roles – GE2023', shows the position titles of voting place roles. Redactions have been made to information that is outside the scope of your request.

The attached pdf 'Training sessions for voting place staff – GE2023', shows the estimated time for each role. All staff are paid to complete their training, both pre-learning and face-to-face. The estimated times for pre-learning cover both reading personal instruction manuals and completing the eLearning modules.
