OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2025/53

Thank you for your request of 8 August 2025 under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) regarding the residential addresses of individuals enrolled in the Ōrākei Local Board Area.

Specifically, you have asked for:

I am seeking a copy of the most up-to-date database of residential addresses of all individuals enrolled to vote in the Ōrākei Local Board area of Auckland.

*Please note I am seeking only the **addresses**, not the names or any other personal identifying information of voters. If possible, I would appreciate this in a structured data format (e.g., CSV or Excel) for analysis purposes.*

If the full request cannot be met, I would be grateful if you could provide the information in part or advise what level of address data (e.g. anonymised or aggregated) can be shared in accordance with privacy obligations.

Please also advise if any conditions or permissions are required for access to this data under section 114 of the Electoral Act 1993 or other applicable legislation.

Your request is refused pursuant to section 18(c)(i) of the Act, as the Electoral Commission making the information available would be contrary to the provisions of a specified enactment. However, you can find the information you are looking for elsewhere. In the interests of transparency, we release responses to Official Information Act requests every three months. We will publish this response with your personal details redacted.
