OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT REQUEST 2025/83

Thank you for your request of 7 November 2025 under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) regarding current addresses for specified individuals. Specifically, you have asked for:

The current address details held by the Electoral Commission of the persons listed in the attached Schedule.


It is compulsory to enrol and the Electoral Act 1993 prescribes how enrolment information can be made available. There is provision for electoral rolls in printed form to be available for purchase or for public inspection at Electoral Commission offices. However, the Act does not allow for me to provide the enrolment details of electors to you on request.

Your request is refused pursuant to section 18(c)(i) of the Act, as the Electoral Commission making the information available would be contrary to the provisions of a specified enactment.

In the interests of transparency, we release responses to Official Information Act requests every 3 months. We will publish this response with your personal details redacted.
