General and Māori electoral populations

In accordance with section 35(6) of the Electoral Act 1993, the results of the Census of Population and Dwellings taken on 7 March 2023, and of the calculation of Māori electoral population and general electoral population (following notification by the Electoral Commission on 5 April 2024 of the number of registered Māori electors) as at 23 October 2024 are set out below.
